1. HOW TO ENTER

- a. These rules govern the KMVQ Jonas Brothers Flyaway to Las Vegas Contest("Contest"), which is being conducted by KMVQ-FM ("Station"). The Contest begins on Friday, March 6, 2020 and ends on Friday, March 20, 2020 ("Contest Dates"). Entrants may enter via on-air only.
- b. To enter the Contest, entrant may enter on-line beginning on Friday, March 6, 2020 at 6:00pm (PT) and ending on Friday, March 6, 2020 at 11:59pm (PT) ("Entry Period") as follows:
  - i. To enter on-air, listen to the station beginning Friday, March 6, 2020 at 6:00pm (PT) through Friday, March 6, 2020 at 6:59pm (PT) for the cue to call to be announced by the on-air host. Caller Ninety-Nine (99) into the studio at 888-456-9970 will be deemed the winner. Only one (1) entry per eligible person during the Entry Period regardless if entrant has more than one email address. Multiple participants are not permitted to share the same email address. P.O. Boxes are not permitted as addresses. Entries submitted may not be acknowledged or returned. Proof of submission of an entry shall not be deemed proof of receipt by the Contest Administrator.
- c. Due to delays in the online streaming of the Station's broadcast signal, listeners to the online stream may not be able to participate in, or may be disadvantaged

in participating in, the Contest. Entrants should not rely on streamed broadcasts and are encouraged to listen to the Station on-air versus online.

- d. The Station is not responsible for any disadvantages or losses that result from online streaming delays of any nature, nor is station otherwise responsible for any delays in online streaming.
- e. Entrants may be provided with an opportunity to opt-in for membership / participation as part of the entry process, but membership / participation is not required to enter the contest.
- f. Only one (1) entry per person is permitted. There will be a total of one (1) grand prize winner selected in the Contest.
- g. All online entries must be received by the end of the Entry Period.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

- a. The Contest is open to all persons who are legal U.S. residents of the state of California, twenty-one (21) years of age or older, and who reside in one of the Nine (9) jurisdictions that make up the listening area of the Greater San Francisco / Bay Area (San Francisco, Santa Clara, Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Mateo, Solano, Napa, and Sonoma Counties). Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
- b. The following individuals are NOT eligible to enter Station contests at any time, even if such individuals meet the age and residency requirements above: (1) Any employees (i.e., full-time, part-time and/or temporary employees) of the Station, Bonneville International Corporation, other area radio stations, Contest Sponsor, of any advertising and promotion agencies, and/or of the respective parent entities, subsidiaries, affiliated companies of each; (2) Any immediate family members of such employees, including without limitation current and/or ex-spouses, parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings, in-laws, and/or steps in any of the foregoing categories; and (3) Any other individual legally residing in the same household (i.e., at the same address) of such employees, including without limitation roommates, housemates, significant others, and partners.
- c. Only one (1) winner, per house for the duration of this contest.
- d. To claim a prize, the winner(s) must provide valid government-issued photo identification and provide their complete address, date of birth and phone number, and Social Security Number.
- e. Entrants are required to provide truthful information and the Station will reject and delete any entry that it discovers to be false or fraudulent. The Station will

disqualify any entrant who does not meet the eligibility requirements and will also delete any entry as required by law.

- f. This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. By participating, entrant agrees to comply with these Official Rules and the decisions of the Station, which are final and binding in all respects.

### 3. PRIZES

- a. One (1) Grand Prizes will be awarded. Each prize consists of two (2) tickets for winner and one (1) guest to see The Jonas brothers Las Vegas Residency at Park MGM Theater in Las Vegas, 3770 S. Las Vegas Blvd, Las Vegas, NV 89109 on Friday, April 3, 2020, Roundtrip airfare for two (2) people from the Bay Area on Thursday, April 2, 2020 to Las Vegas and back on Saturday, April 4, 2020, and Hotel lodging for two (2) nights at an MGM property in a double occupancy hotel room for two (2) people. The Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of the prize(s) is \$1,600. Winners must be able to travel Thursday, April 2, 2020 through Saturday, April 4, 2020. Transportation costs are excluded in the given price. Actual value may vary based on dates of travel. Any difference between stated value and actual value will not be awarded. Certain restrictions may apply and is subject to hotel availability. Advanced reservations are required. If the winner(s) cannot travel on date(s) specified by the Station, the winner may be disqualified, and an alternate winner will not be selected. The winner's guests must be either twenty-one (21) years of age or older or must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older. Actual value may vary based on point of departure and dates of travel. Any difference between stated value and actual value will not be awarded. Certain travel restrictions may apply. Travel arrangements must be made through the Station or its designee. Prize(s) is subject to availability. If the winner(s) cannot travel on date(s) specified by the Station, the winner(s) may be disqualified, and an alternate winner(s) may be selected (time permitting) at the Station's sole discretion. Station will determine itinerary and airline, if applicable, in its sole discretion. The winner(s) and guest(s) must sign an IRS Form W-9, affidavit of acceptance, eligibility, liability, publicity release, and if applicable, Contest Sponsor liability release forms prior to traveling. If a prize-related event or travel is unable to take place as scheduled, for reasons such as cancellation, preemption, postponement or unavailability, including for weather, or for any reason beyond the control of the

Contest Administrator or Sponsor, their sole responsibility to the winner(s) will be to award the remaining available elements of the prize(s) and no substitution or compensation will be provided for the unawarded elements of the prize(s). No refund or compensation will be made in the event of the cancellation or delay of any flight. Tickets are not refundable or transferable and may not be substituted or exchanged for cash or credit at any time, nor will tickets be replaced if lost or stolen. Tickets may not be sold to a third party. All sales, prizes and other taxes, gratuities and any other incidentals associated with the prizes are the sole responsibility of the prizewinner(s). Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and may not be substituted, except by sponsors for reasons of unavailability, in which case, a prize of equal or greater value will be awarded. The Station assumes no responsibility or liability for damages, loss, or injury resulting from acceptance or use of the prize. The Station is not responsible for replacing tickets in the event of show cancellations as a result of weather, or promoter, or performer actions. The Station reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Contest should a virus, bug, computer, or other problem beyond the control of the Station corrupt the administration, security, or proper execution of the Contest, or the Internet portion of the Contest. Decisions of the Station are final.

- b. If due to a printing, production or other error, more prizes are claimed than are intended to be awarded for any prize level, the intended prizes will be awarded in a random drawing from among all verified and validated prize claims received for that prize level. In no event will more than the stated number of prizes be awarded.

#### 4. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

- a. Decisions of the Station management with respect to the Contest are final.
- b. One (1) grand prize winner will be selected in the Contest on Friday, March 6, 2020 between 6:00pm (PT) and 6:59pm (PT) during the following periods of time (“Drawing Periods”).
- c. Odds of winning are one (1) out of one (1).
- d. Entries are specific to each designated Drawing Period and will not be included in subsequent drawings.
- e. Winners must listen to the Station to win but do not need to be present to win. All prizes may be picked up at the office of the Station at 201 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite #1200, San Francisco, CA 94103 between regular business hours of 9:00am (PT) to 4:00pm (PT). If a winner chooses to have a prize shipped, the Winner will be required to sign a release that the Station and any Released Parties (defined below) are not responsible if the prize is late, lost, stolen, misdirected, undeliverable, or damaged during shipping. In such cases, there is no

purchase necessary to enter or win, except for reasonable postage and handling fees the amount of which shall not exceed \$1.50 plus the actual cost of postage to ship the prize.

- f. Potential winner(s) will be notified of winning by telephone at the time of the drawing. Prize(s) will be awarded only upon confirmation of eligibility and completion of all requisite releases. The Station's or its Contest Administrator's computer or telephone system is the official time keeping device for this Contest. In the event of a dispute, online entries will be deemed to have been submitted by the Authorized Account Holder. The "Authorized Account Holder" is the natural person who (i) is assigned to an email address by an internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address, or (ii) is assigned to the mobile telephone number by a telecommunications provider, or other organization that is responsible for assigning such numbers. The Station, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person who it believes is tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest. Failure to comply with the rules of the Contest may result in an entrant's disqualification and/or forfeiture of any prize or prizes. If the Station makes a good-faith determination that an entrant has cheated or committed fraudulent activity in

- b. The Station reserves the right to modify these rules for clarification or equitable purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the Contest, including, without limitation, the substitution of a prize(s) of equivalent value, which will become effective upon announcement. To the extent the Station makes material changes to the terms and conditions of the Contest, any such material changes will be broadcast on the Station and/or posted on its website: [www.997now.com](http://www.997now.com) within twenty-four (24) hours of the change and periodically thereafter. If due to circumstances beyond the control of the Station, any competition or prize-related event or travel is delayed, rescheduled, postponed or cancelled, the Station reserves the right, but does not have the obligation, to cancel, terminate, suspend, or modify the Contest and shall not be required to award a substitute prize(s). If any provision of these Official Rules is irrevocably inconsistent with any provision set forth on the Contest webpage, then the provision of these Official Rules will prevail but solely to the extent of the inconsistency.
- c. Calling the Station regarding the Contest constitutes permission for the Station to tape the caller's voice and use it on the air. The Released Parties are not responsible for (i) typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering, or the administration of the Contest or in the announcement of a prize; (ii) incorrect or inaccurate information, human error, failure, or omission; (iii) unauthorized human intervention; (iv) lost, stolen, mangled, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, or late entries; (v) entries not received due to difficulty accessing the internet, service outage or delays, computer difficulties, telephone service outages, delays, busy signals, poor signals or signal interference, accidental disconnection, equipment malfunctions, and any other technological failures; or (vi) any cancellations, delays, diversions, or substitutions or omissions by any transportation providers or any other persons or entities providing any services to Entrant(s) and/or winner(s) (and winner's guest(s) if applicable) including any results thereof such as changes in services or location necessitated by same. Further, the Released Parties are not responsible if any part of a Contest cannot be conducted and/or if a prize, either in whole or in part, cannot be awarded due to acts of God, acts of war, natural disasters, weather, acts of terrorism, or other factors beyond the Released Parties' control.
- g. be awarded (collectively, “Special Damages”), and (4) entrant hereby waives all rights to claim Special Damages and all rights to have any damages awarded multiplied or increased. Utah law governs the interpretation and construction of these Official Rules and all aspects related thereto.

- a.
